- **Supporting details** are in the middle of a paragraph. These sentences explain the main idea. They give extra details that the topic sentence did not explain.
- A conclusion sentence ends a strong paragraph. It is a short summary of the paragraph's main idea. It might sound similar to the topic sentence!
